This release provides the following new features:

- Support for SQL Server/Analysis Services 2008.
- Support for DB2 and Oracle in Extended Builder 2005.
- Supports Active Directories with more than 32,000 accounts.
- Supports SSL connections in Reporting Services
- Resolves issues with capitalization of user accounts in administrative modules.
- Resolves issues when retrieving data while a dimension has a calculation, suppression on, and certain selections.
- Resolves issues with custom bands and Ad hoc groups.
- Resolves issues with customs footers.
- Other minor bug fixes.
